TEXAS AND THE GENERAL

In December of 1855, The locomotive 'General' was was built by Rogers, Ketchum & Grosvenor of Paterson, New Jersey. Shortly thereafter, in October of 1856, 'Texas' was built by Danforth, Cooke and Company also in Paterson, New Jersey. Both these 4-4-0 locomotives led rather placid existances moving freight for the Western and Atlantic Railroad in Georgia.

All that changed in April of 1862. James Andrews, a civilian from Kentucky, made a living painting houses and smuggling contraband quinine from the north for confederate soldiers and civilians. Andrews was obviously not one to choose sides. While working as an agent of the North he offered Major General Ormsby Mitchell a plot to steal a southern locomotive and drive it north to rendezvous with the northern army in Chattanooga, TN. The objective was to tear up track and cut telegraph wires behind him, preventing the South from sending reinforcements to the battle lines.

On April 12, the plot became reality. Andrews, another civilian William Campbell, and 18 out of an original group of 22 Ohio infantry volunteers boarded the General at Marrietta, GA. They operated under the cover of a group from Fleming County, Kentucky looking to join a Kentucky based Confederate regiment. When the train made it's breakfast stop in Big Shanty and the crew departed, the group made it's move. As the stolen locomotive and three empty boxcars pulled away from the station, the conductor, William Fuller, looked up from his breakfast and watched it pull away. Fuller and two others begin the pursuit on foot, running two miles to the next station where the chase continued in a handcar. Reaching the Etowah station, Fuller found the recently arrived locomotive 'Yonah' still at steam. In short order it was a new chase.

Passing several stations, the renegade crew of the General cut several telegraph wires and piled ties on the track when they were able. Upon steaming into Kingston, GA. they found, to their misfortune, that several trains loaded with supplies are headed south escaping northern General Mitchell who had just captured Huntsville. After waiting for three trains to pass and more yet to come they decided to make a break for it and try to beat the next southbound train. When they reached Adairsville, they were able to pass the next southbound train, the Texas. ... To be continued in next month's Issue of 'The Inside Track'
