TEXAS AND THE GENERAL - Continued

When William Fuller and the locomotive "Yonah" arrived in Kingston, they were faced with the same traffic problem that had met the General. Rather than wait, Fuller ran to the head of the line and the locomotive "William R. Smith". Now with a new ride they headed north with Fuller riding the front of the locomotive, looking for obstructions. It was well he did, as before long, he spotted a rail that Andrew's crew had removed. With luck, they were able to stop in time. Once more on foot, Fuller ran three miles to the oncoming Texas and engineer Pete Bracken. Quickly they threw the Texas in reverse and returned to Adairsville. Once there, they dropped the extra cars they were carrying and the Great Locomotive Chase was on... still in reverse.

Soon thereafter, James Andrews and his men heard, from the south, the sound of a steam horn. They knew they were pursued. Upon reaching the covered Oostanaula trestle, they tried to burn it along with a boxcar and some of their tender wood. Unfortunately, with several days of rain, the car and trestle were waterlogged and never really set to burning well. Obstructing the line with the still smoldering boxcar and wooden ties piled on the rail they continued on toward Chattanooga. For Fuller, the Oostanaula trestle proved to be only a minor delay as they quickly removed the ties, pushed the boxcar to a siding and resumed the chase.

The locomotive robbers sailed through the next town of Dalton, but Fuller dropped off a telegraph operator to wire ahead to the confederate commander in Chattanooga. Unknown to Andrews, half the message got through before they next stopped to cut the wire. Worse yet, Andrew's crew and the General were running out of wood and water to power the steam engine. Eighteen miles short of their destination the General ran out of steam. The men scattered for the woods without the protection of the Union Army, for worst of all, Northern General Ormsby Mitchell had failed to take Chattanooga.

Within days confederate forces captured all the men, including two who arrived too late to board the train back in Marietta. A week later James Andrews and seven others were hung as spies. Fourteen men attempted to escape and eight of them reached Union lines. The remaining six were later exchanged in a swap of prisoners. For their daring deeds, the union soldiers received Medals of Honor. As civilians, James Andrews and William Campbell were not eligible and received no official recognition.
