THE GOLDEN SPIKES?

We all know of the famous Golden Spike driven to complete the Transcontinental Railroad at Promontory Summit, Utah on May 10, 1869. But what of the not as famous Silver Spike or of the other precious metal spikes?

The Golden Spike, we all know, commissioned by contractor David Hewes, was made by the William T. Garatt Foundry in San Francisco. It is 5-5/8 inches long and contained 14.03 ounces of 17.6 karat gold. The spike was given to Leland Stanford, President of the Central Pacific to be used as the last spike connecting the East to the West. A second golden spike, 5-1/2 inches long and of 9.5 ounces was commissioned by Frederick Marriot owner of the San Francisco News Letter. Assayers E. Ruhling & Co. of Virginia City, Nevada provided the 25 ounces of silver required by the Dowling Blacksmith Shop to forge a 6 inch long 10.5 ounce silver spike presented by U.S. Commissioner J. W. Haines from the State of Nevada. Arizona Territory Governor Anson P. K. Safford brought a 6 inch iron spike with gold and silver of unknown make.

All of these spikes were tapped into a highly polished and pre drilled California laurel wood tie ordered by CP supplier West Evans from billiard table manufacturer Strahle & Hughes. L. W. Coe, president of Pacific Union Express Company had the spike maul made by toolmaker Conroy and O'Conner heavily plated with silver by Vanderslice & Co. of San Francisco to drive the spikes. Immediately after the precious spikes were "driven", they and the laurel tie were removed. A conventional tie was put in place and after a couple of misfires by Stanford and UP Vice President Thomas Durant the final iron spike was driven, completing the ceremony at 12:47 p.m.

Unknown at the time, Mr. Hewes had made another identical golden spike, kept by his family until it surfaced in 2005. It is on display at the California State Railroad Museum. The original Golden Spike, the Nevada silver spike and silver maul are all now part of the Stanford University Museum. Currently on loan from the Museum of the City of New York the Arizona Territory spike is held in the collection of the Union Pacific Railroad Museum in Council Bluffs, Iowa. The laurel tie went to the San Francisco offices of the Central Pacific, which had reorganized into the Southern Pacific. It was subsequently lost in the earthquake and fires of 1906. The location of the San Francisco News spike is unknown and may also have been lost in the earthquake.
