LELAND STANFORD, RAILROAD TYCOON

Throughout his life, Leland Stanford mirrored one of his greatest accomplishments. He was a transcontinental gentleman. Born in Watervliet, New York in 1824, he was one of eight children of prosperous farmers, Josiah and Elizabeth Stanford. After many years of higher education he joined the Albany law offices of Wheaton, Doolittle & Hadley and passed the bar exam in 1848.

Leland moved to Port Washington, Wisconsin and took up a law practice with a Mr. Wesley Pierce. Leland's father provided him with a law library said to be the finest north of Milwaukee. Jane Elizabeth Lathrop of Albany married Leland in 1850. Also in 1850, he was nominated as Washington County, Wisconsin District Attorney and founded the Washington Herald as well.

By 1852, Leland Stanford had lost his Wisconsin property as well as his library in a fire. He then decided to try his luck and followed his successful brothers to California. True to the family pattern, Leland did very well selling mining equipment during the gold rush. At this time, he also became a Justice of the Peace and helped to organize what would later become the Sacramento Library. For a short while in 1855 he returned to Albany to be with his wife. Living in Albany, though, did not suit Leland and the next year he and his wife found themselves in San Francisco.

Leland tried hard to get into California politics, helping to set up the California Republican Party. Initially, politics did not come easy for Leland. He was defeated in attempts to become the California State Treasurer in 1857 and Governor in 1859. The third time was indeed Leland's charm and he was elected to the Governorship in 1861. He also served in the U.S. Senate from 1885 until he died in 1889.

In 1885 Leland and his wife Jane founded the Leland Stanford Junior University in honor of their son Leland who had died of typhoid the year before in Florence, Italy. During opening exercises on October 1, 1891, the first student enrolled that day was Herbert Hoover.

All of Leland Stanford's other accomplishments are too numerous to include in this short excerpt of his life. A short list would include the Pacific Union Express Company, the Palo Alto Stock Farm, numerous wineries, hotels, etc. One might have also heard that Leland Stanford had something to do with railroads, what with the Central Pacific Railroad, the first transcontinental rail line and the Golden Spike and all.
