## ANDREW CARNEGIE, MAN OF STEEL

In 1873, when Andrew Carnegie built his first steel plant, he named it the Edgar Thomson Steel Works after his former boss and president of the Pennsylvania Railroad. By late 1875 the plant's first run of liquid steel was produced to create 2,000 steel rails, destined for the Pennsylvania Railroad. At this time the mill was capable of producing 225 tons of steel rail every day. In 1901 Carnegie sold Carnegie Steel, parent of the Edgar Thomson Steel Works, to U.S. Steel. By 2005 this plant produced 2.8 million tons of steel, more than one quarter of all steel produced by U.S. Steel that year. This historic landmark is still in operation with blast furnaces No. 1 and No. 3 still producing steel.

With the sale of Carnegie Steel, Andrew Carnegie retired from business. His 1901 steel industries sale to U.S. Steel netted \$480 million of which he personally received over \$225 million. When the United States purchased the Philippines from Spain in 1898 for \$20 million, Carnegie viewed this as an imperialistic move. He personally offered the Philippines \$20 million with which they could buy their independence. Unfortunately this did not come to be and the Philippine-American War ensued. By this time Andrew had already written extensively, producing books promoting the values of the U.S. Republican system of government. He also contributed articles to magazines advocating for the wealthy to engage in philanthropic pursuits. Having seen much outside the U.S., Carnegie would go on to write three books on travel.

Besides philanthropy, one of Carnegie's greatest passions was books. Establishing libraries throughout the U.S., U.K., and elsewhere was a great priority for him. The first was established in his hometown of Dunfermline, Scotland in 1883. The first in the U.S. in 1889 was in Braddock, Pennsylvania. Not wanting to fight the racial standards of the day, Carnegie would create two separate libraries in a town so that the African Americans would have their own library. A lamp post or lantern would grace the front of each building, as a symbol of "enlightenment". Between 1883 and 1929, 2,509 Carnegie libraries were built. In 1919, nearly half of all the libraries in the U.S. were built with grants from Carnegie.

When Carnegie died on 11 August 1919 of bronchial pneumonia, he had given away \$350,695,653. After his death, \$30 million more was given to various charities. He was buried at the Sleepy Hollow Cemetery in North Tarrytown, New York.
