THE OVERSEAS RAILROAD

Henry Morrison Flagler was known as the father of Miami. During the Gilded Age, Flagler was a co-founder of Standard Oil with John D Rockefeller. In the late 1800s took an interest in Florida to provide a warmer climate for his ailing wife. He was a major force in the development of the resort cities of St. Augustine, Daytona Beach and Palm Beach. After the construction of the Panama Canal, Flagler saw the advantage that Key West could provide as the closest deep water port in the United States. Flagler's vision to connect Key West to the mainland resulted in what was thought of by some as "Flagler's Folly".

The extension of the Florida East Coast Railway projected 128 miles from the tip of the Florida peninsula. The seven year construction employed as many as 4,000 men and cost \$50 million to complete. Three times from 1906 through 1910 the project was threatened by hurricanes. At the completion of the rail line in 1912, Henry Flagler rode a private car in the first train to reach Key West. Headlines of that day declared the line the "Eighth Wonder of the World". Sadly, though his dream was realized and the Overseas Railroad continued on, Henry Flagler died the following year at the age of 83 after a fall in his home.

On September 1, 1935 a storm was forming near the southern tip of Andros Island in the Bahamas. Later that day in the heat of the Gulf Stream it strengthened and turned northward toward Islamorada in the Upper Keys. At that time hundreds of WW I veterans were working out of tent camps while building roads and structure in Upper Matecumbe Key. Hastily a rescue train was assembled and sent to their rescue. The train crew raced to add cars and get to the camps to evacuate the men. Hoping to rescue the men within four hours, the trip took five for the train to arrive and load in Islamorada. Unfortunately the hurricane had arrived and very the lower the train to arrive the train to arrive the train to arrive and load in Islamorada. as well. A seventeen foot tidal swell swept over the train. Only the locomotive remained standing. Over 400 were killed on the train and in the surrounding areas.

Nearly every building in Islamorada was destroyed. Bridges and railway embankments were washed away. The Florida East Coast Railway, already in financial straits was unable to rebuild the damaged sections. What was left of the rail line was sold to the state of Florida. Much of the rail bed and bridges were used to create U.S. 1 the Overseas Highway and the Florida Keys Overseas Heritage Trail.
