JIM FISK, HERO OF THE GOLDEN AGE

In the past we have brought you stories of the scoundrels, robbers and robber barons of the railroad's Golden Age, but in the spirit of the New Year, perhaps we should look at those that may also have been pretty good at heart. Jim Fisk was well known as one of the scoundrels of Wall Street, one of the robber barons, right along with Jay Gould that created the original 1869 Black Friday crash of the gold and stock markets. Many believe, however that there was a lot more to the man than that.

Prior to becoming the Wall Street financier for which he was so well known, Fisk sold textiles and made a good fortune at it. Even earlier occupations within the circus had set him up with a carnival barker mentality that served him well. Near the end of the Civil War, his salesmanship allowed him to garner many government contracts for uniforms, underwear, socks and blankets. Though many of the mechanisms he used to procure his supplies and raw materials were questionable, he always made sure the products supplied to the military were of good quality. "The man that will take the upper hand of a soldier in the field is worse than a thief." he had said.

Later, while the Great Chicago Fire hit the city, Jim Fisk drove a wagon with a team of horses through the streets of New York collecting goods and provisions to be sent to the survivors of the fire. Mr. Fisk ordered that the lines be cleared and the "Lightning Express", a train filled with the provisions was sent to the city as quickly as possible.

Some may have questioned Fisk's motives as to whether they were pure or self aggrandizing, but in either case, those in need did benefit from his actions. After his death, a folk song was written in his honor; a portion of which is below:

"If a man was in trouble he would help him along,

To drive the grim wolf from the door,
He strove to do right, though he may have done wrong,

But he never went back on the poor."
