JAY GOULD, PHILANTHROPIST

Like anyone in the public eye, Jay Gould had a difficult time dealing with public perception. As fodder for reporters looking to maximize readership, scandal far outweighs charity. Mr. Gould was clearly no saint, as his appetite for the consumption of Wall Street and his attempts to corner the gold market clearly indicated. However those who worked for Gould and gave him their loyalty were often well rewarded in kind.

Perhaps much of Gould's Robber Baron image, which persists to this day, is based on his realization, that it was futile to fight it. Never a showman, Gould dressed well, but not with grand style. Like many driven people, his energies were reserved for his current focus, whatever it may have been. Apart from business, many of the things that interested Gould were family, books and flowers. His home and wife, Helen, were his respite from the rest of the world. None of these would interest those out to spread a bit of gossip.

Even his charities were low key and generally local. When yellow fever stuck Memphis in late 1879, Gould donated \$10,000.00 to the Howard Foundation, exhorting them to keep up their good works and he would foot the bill. That value of labor in today's costs would equal more that \$3,000,000.00. Shortly thereafter he send \$5,000.00 to farmers along the Kansas Pacific struggling with crop shortages. Much of his philanthropy was spent in support of his extended family. When his sister Sarah's husband died, Gould made sure all fifteen of their children continued in school and never missed out on Christmas. Gould insisted on detailed accounts of each child's progress.

Unfortunately, the conflicts on time for business and family proved difficult for Gould. Ultimately, it resolved to a desire to leave his businesses to his family. Upon his death, his estate was divided equally among his children.
