#### THE TRAILS OF AMERICAN RAIL

Though rail was not here during the time America forged its independence, none can doubt the impact it has had on what it and we have become. And, though not here as long as our independence, rail has been here long enough for many lines to have come and gone. Some of these long gone lines have traveled through some historic as well as some very scenic locations. Thankfully, much of the labor and hardships of laying many of these lines have been preserved as trails available to all who are adventurous enough to take advantage of them.

The Illinois Prairie Path is the first rail line in the country to be converted to a non-motorized, multiuse trail. It follows the right of way of the former Chicago, Aurora & Elgin Railway. The CA&E Suspended operations in 1959 and abandoned the right of way in 1961. On September 30, 1963 the Chicago Tribune published a letter from May Theilgaard Watts trying to encourage a public path on the abandoned route. Her idea was a hit. From 1966 through 1986, volunteers cleared the way and built the bridges for the path. From 1986 on the path has been maintained by various public and private partnerships in Kane, Cook and DuPage counties and covers approximately 61 miles.

In 1965 the state of Wisconsin purchased the 32 mile right of way for the Elroy Sparta Trail from the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad and turned it into one of the first Rails to Trails paths in the nation. The Elroy-Sparta Trail is famous for its three rail tunnels. Two tunnels are 1,680 feet long and the other an incredible 3,810 feet long.

The Rails to Trails Conservancy consists of over 160,000 members and supporters and more than 31,000 miles of rail trails and multi-use trails. With an eye on 8,000 more miles yet to be built, the RTC could use all the help they can get.
