EMPLOYING AN UNCONVENTIONAL WORKFORCE

Back in 2007 the French rail network, SNCF Reseau created contracts for the Rhine-Rhone high speed rail line including clauses providing jobs for the unemployed. 7% of all working hours were to be allocated to applicants, geared to bring them back to stabile employment. Even then, work on the line had exceeded that figure, reaching an average of almost 20%, with more than 550 people recruited to comply with this requirement.

In 2011, when the eastern stretch of the line was done, the 'social clause' in the contracts meant that 989 disadvantaged individuals had been employed during the project. The percentages of workers had to come from specific disadvantaged groups. Out of the 989, 44% were long-term unemployed and 19% had previously received RMI, a French welfare benefit for working age adults that haven't worked in the past. In addition, 10% of the group were unemployed and over 50, and 2% had physical disabilities.

Currently in the UK, a new project, HS2 is following the same path. There have been whole new universities created for the industries related to high speed rail. The region around Leeds in the UK expects to create 40,000 new jobs in high speed rail with 5% of them to be previously unemployed workers.

Is there the same opportunity to expand and vitalize an underserved workforce here in the U.S.? The U.S. could use an update to our transportation infrastructure as well as the new job opportunities.
