THE CREDIT MOBILIER SCANDAL PART II

In 1864 Thomas Durant purchased the Pennsylvania Fiscal Agency and soon changed the name to Credit Mobilier of America. It was purported to be a construction company hired by the Union Pacific to construct their portion of the Transcontinental Railroad. It was to become one of the first shell companies in America..

The federal government had provided the UP with very generous loans and land grants to construct the railroad.. Much of this money was funneled to Credit Mobilier. The company's sole purpose was to obtain credit and extend contracts with limited liability. Most often these contracts were awarded to associates of Credit Mobilier. These costs were vastly inflated and then passed on the the Union Pacific and by extension the taxpayers. It is estimated that the constructions costs were overbilled by approximately \$50 million. The stockholders of the company enjoyed enormous profits.

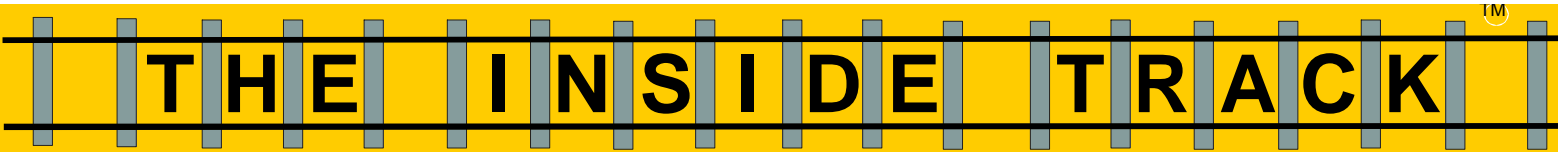
In 1865, Oakes Ames, a Massachusetts representative of the U.S Congress, along with his brother Oliver, purchased stocks in Credit Mobilier. By 1867 there was dissension in the ranks and Oakes Ames took control of Credit Mobilier and Oliver became president of the company. Because of the association with the Union Pacific, much of the money paid to Credit Mobilier for construction was instead used to buy stock in Union Pacific at face value and then sold to the open market to the public creating another large profit.

As may be expected, with politicians involved, the story is not yet over.
