UNION STATION

Locally, many cities consider Union Station to be their own great rail station, but there are nearly 100 stations in the U.S. named Union. This is because, Union is actually more of a type of station than a name. These stations are unions of multiple carriers. The grand histories of these terminals often eclipse the rather mundane origin of their name. Such rail stations with beautiful, spacious and luxuriant halls lend credence to this image. Famous Union Stations span the country from Washington DC to Los Angeles, CA. Many are listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Union Station, Washington DC was designed by the Famous Architect Daniel Burnham and was complete in 1908. It is faced with Bethel white granite and gold leaf in soaring neoclassical style. A 210,00 square foot mall within the original Main Concourse includes many restaurants and shops.

Chicago Union Station, was also designed by Daniel Burnham. Unfortunately he died before plans were completed and it was completed by Graham, Anderson, Probst and White. Designed in the Beaux-Art style, It was faced with Bedford limestone quarried in Indiana. It boasts a 219 foot long skylight 115 feet above the floor. Construction began in 1913 and was completed in 1925.

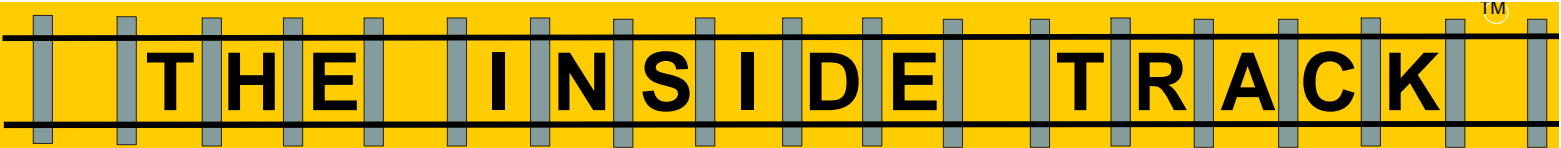
Kansas City Union Station was built in 1914 and was designed by Chicago architect Jarvis Hunt. Also designed in the Beaux-Art style, it includes 95 foot high coffered ceilings with three chandeliers weighing 3,500 lb. each. The station includes a Planetarium, City Stage Live Theatre, Regnier Movie Theatre, Science City, restaurants and shopping.

Union Station, Los Angeles opened in May of 1939. Designed by the father and son team of John and Donald Parkinson in a mix of Spanish Colonial, Mission Revival and Art Deco, it includes terracotta and marble floors. The walls are faced with travertine and acoustical tile. It is complete with garden patios, courtyards and beautiful outdoor spaces with orange trees, palms and magnolias. The famous Harvey House restaurant also resides within.

None of this should dissuade you from visiting your city's Unions Station or any of a number of other beautiful stations you may find!
