MARY JANE COLTER

In the early 1900's railroad travelers were used to seeing architecture in european styles. Mary Jane Colter was among the first to turn their eyes toward native themes. Employed by the Fred Harvey Company as chief architect and designer, Colter designed may of the hotels, buildings and lodges along the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway and the South Rim of the Grand Canyon.

Mary Jane Colter was born in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania in 1869, but she lived and grew in Minnesota, Colorado and Texas before attending the California School of Design in San Francisco. In 1902 through her contacts with the Fred Harvey Company, she landed a job as interior designer of the Indian House next to the Alvarado Hotel in Albuquerque, along the Santa Fe main line.

Using natural materials, Colter became famous for designs that paid tribute to native art and structure. She is most famous for her designs along the South Rim of the Grand Canyon such as the Hopi House located near the El Tovar Hotel and the Grand Canyon Station. Designed as a Hopi dwelling with red sandstone and tiny windows, it actually housed many of the Hopi that worked on the building. She designed the Lookout Studio on the edge of a precipice just west of the Hopi House to present a fabulous view of the canyon.

Some of her other works include the Hermit's Rest several miles to the west of Hopi House and the Indian Watchtower on the eastern end of the South Rim. Mary Jane Colter designed and created the prized Mimbreño china and flatware for the Super Chief Chicago-Los Angeles rail service of the Santa Fe Railroad in 1936. Mimbreño china is avidly collected to this day. Colter remained in association with the Fred Harvey Company for 46 years until her retirement in 1948 at the age of 76.
